

ACCEPTABLE FORMS OF PHOTO ID

- Valid NC Driver's License
- Driver's License from another state. Voter must register in NC within 90 days of Nov. 5
- US Passport or US Passport card
- NC voter photo ID card, issued by a county BOE
- Student & government-employee photo IDs approved by the State Board of Elections
- Military or veterans photo ID card (with photo) issued by the US government
- ID card (with photo) issued by an agency of the US or NC government for a public assistance program
- Tribal enrollment card (with photo) issued by a tribe recognized by the State or federal government
